The continuing education must be in an Agriculture related field in a fully credited college in the United States. If you are selected for a Scholarship – **the check will be made payable to the college you are attending.**

The Queen Anne's County Young Farmer's are offering one or more scholarships with an amount to be determined. The scholarship committee will review the application.

Qualification are:

- **Must have a grade point average of 2.5 or higher.**
- **One Page Essay and Application Completed:**
How can QAC Young Farmers market themselves to future youth? How to gain their involvement in our program?
- **Money must be used in furthering his/her education in Agriculture.**
- **Transcripts of the recipient's grades must be sent to Queen Anne's Farm Bureau Office at the end of semester.**
- **Must have a current family membership with Queen Anne's County Farm Bureau.**

Although this scholarship is for one fiscal year, the recipient may reapply. A snapshot and article of the recipient may be published in local papers in cooperation with Queen Anne's County Farm Bureau and Young Farmer's.
